Communication and Language

This is a prime area and aspect that underpins everything we do in nursery. We encourage as much conversation and opportunities for talking as possible.

 Nursery 2 children will begin 'Chatting with Children' in a small group time to develop their listening and attention skills, their understanding and speaking.

Mathematics:

We are learning:

- •To represent, sort and compare 1,2 and 3.
- ·Match numerals to pictures
- To recite numbers
- •To know that the last number reached when counting a set of objects tells you how many there are in total.
- •Show fingers up to 3 in different ways, recognising that the total is still the same.
- ·Subitising to 3 and beyond
- •To compare one more and one less
- •About the composition of numbers 1,2 and 3.
- About circles and triangles
- ·We will be exploring measuring and capacity.



Physical Development Gross Motor Skills: We will be learning to:

- Do our zips up on our coats and fasten buttons on cardigans
- Climbing on the trim trail and apparatus

Develop ball skills: rolling, throwing and catching

Please support your child by encouraging them to zip up their own coats

Fine Motor Skills:

We will do daily activities to develop the strength and movement in our hands, fingers and thumbs including:

- Dough Disco
- Squiggle Whilst You Wiggle
- Cutting We will be developing our scissors skills, holding the scissors correctly and using them to snip

Expressive Art and Design

We will be learning to:

- Mix colours
- Do observational drawings and paintings with a focus on flowers using Van Gogh as inspiration.
- · Use watercolours
- Make transient art and look at the work of Andy Goldsworthy
- Create Easter nests, baskets and cards

- · The story of Easter




Literacy-
