Facebook

As many of you will know the school has its own Facebook page which is well used by staff and parents. It helps with communication, messages, reminders as well as being somewhere to celebrate and share children's work.

Some classes find it helpful to have an informal Facebook page organised by themselves for communication about things happening at school in their child's class. This is a great idea and I am in support of anything that helps parents keep in touch with what is going on at school. For those parents/carers who do use Facebook in this way please remember that it should only be used for the sharing of information and that comments about other parents/carers, the school or staff would result in an investigation by the school and would be taken very seriously.

Absence from school

If your child has sickness and/or diarrhoea they should not return to school until 48 hours have passed from the last vomiting or diarrhoea attack.

Children with infections such as impetigo and conjunctivitis need to be seen by a doctor or pharmacist and advice taken as to whether absence from school is necessary. Both of these infections are very contagious and are commonly spread easily amongst children via physical touch of the hands.

Celebration Assemblies

We love our Celebration assemblies on Friday mornings and are always delighted at the support and attendance they receive on a weekly basis. It is a great way to involve the wider school community. Please help us to maintain the standards we try to set for the children by keeping conversations for before or after the assembly has finished so that the awards, singing and presentation can be enjoyed by all.

There will be a PTFA Hot Dog Night on Thursday 13th October at 3.15 - 5.00pm. The film being shown is Zootroplolis (PG). It appears that most 'children's' films are now given a PG certificate. Consent is given by parents/carers purchasing a ticket for the event from the school office. Please also remember that children in nursery and reception must be accompanied by a grown up to this event.

Nut allergy in school

We have a child in school that is allergic to pistachio, cashew and pesto. We ask that parents/carers provide packed lunches that <u>DO NOT</u> contain any of these things in them please. Children with a nut allergy can have something called anaphylactic shock which can be very dangerous. We need to be a school that is free from pistachio, cashew and pesto.

School Dinners

If your child wishes to move from school dinners to packed lunch we must have a minimum of 1 weeks notice in writing to the school office. As we do not have a working kitchen, meals are ordered from North Tyneside and therefore must be ordered in advance. School are still charged for meals your child doesn't take, even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 and entitled to a free school meal. This means the school covers the cost for the meals in Key Stage 1 rather than you as parents and while we receive some funding towards this the school still has to pay. Also, please be aware we are only able to make changes to school dinner choices within the first 3 weeks of term as agreed with North Tyneside Council as part of their agreement to supply our meals.
