This week has been a challenging week with many positive cases of Covid-19 in school. Thank you to all of our families for keeping in touch with us so effectively and the regular updates. The most important thing is that everyone is recovering quite quickly, with parents and carers keen for children to return to school as quickly as possible. The current guidance is that people can test from day 5 and so long as two negative LFD test results are recorded (on consecutive days), children and staff can return to school. The vast majority of people are still requiring a 7-day isolation period with very few testing negative on day 5.
