Key Objectives for Year 1	
Writing	<p>Read and write the capital letter form of each letter.</p> <p>Write sentences that start with a capital letter and end with a full stop.</p> <p>Use 'and' to join ideas.</p> <p>Use conjunctions to join sentences (e.g. so, but).</p> <p>Use tense correctly eg 'went' not 'goed'.</p> <p>In writing, show evidence of; full stops, question marks, exclamation marks.</p> <p>Use capital letters for names and personal pronoun 'I'.</p> <p>Write clearly sequenced sentences.</p> <p>Correct formation of capital and lower case - starting and finishing in right place.</p> <p>Correct formation of digits.</p>
Reading	<p>Identify which words appear again and again.</p> <p>Relate reading to own experiences.</p> <p>Re-read to correct- if reading does not make sense.</p> <p>Re-tell with considerable accuracy.</p> <p>Discuss significance of title and events.</p> <p>Make predictions on basis of what has been read.</p> <p>Make inferences on basis of what is said and done.</p> <p>Read with pace and expression. I.e. pause at a full stop and raise voice for question.</p> <p>Know difference between fiction and non-fiction.</p> <p>Be secure at Phase 5 phonics.</p>
Maths	<p>Count to and across 100, forwards and backwards from any number.</p> <p>Read and write numbers to 20 in digits and words.</p> <p>Read and write numbers to 100 in digits.</p> <p>Say 1 more and 1 less than numbers to 100.</p> <p>Count in multiples of 1, 2, 5 and 10.</p> <p>Know bonds to 10 by heart.</p> <p>Add and subtract: 1 digit and 2 digit numbers to 20, including zero.</p> <p>Add any three 1-digit numbers with a total up to 20.</p> <p>Solve simple multiplication and division with apparatus and arrays.</p>

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Recognise half and quarter of object, shape or quantity.
Sequence events in order. Know months of the year in order.
Use language of day, week, month and year.
