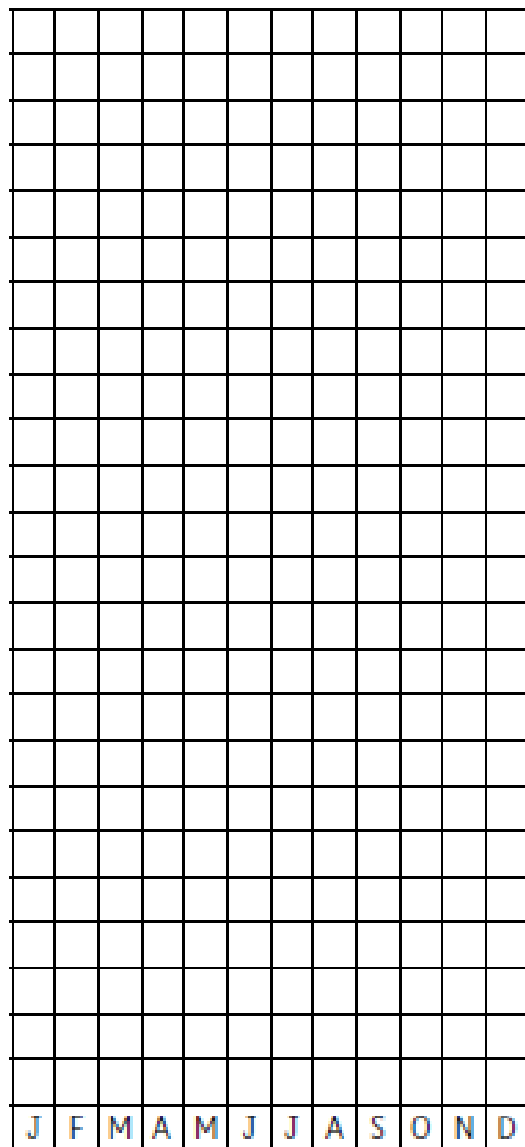

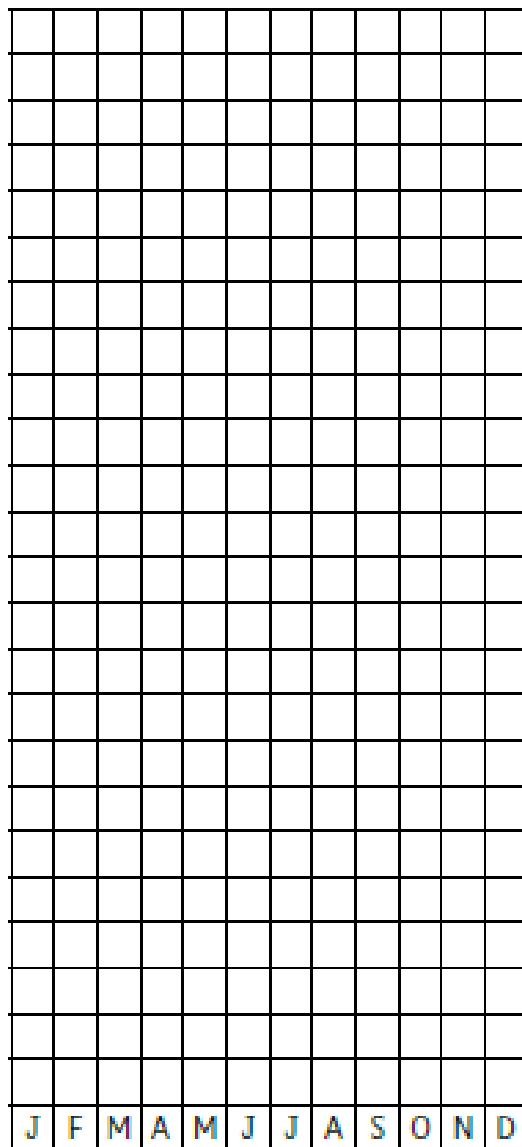
Shade the daylight hours for each month in yellow. Shade the remaining blocks in dark blue.
