### School Wraparound Club and 30-Hour Nursery Provision

We are able to confirm that the 'Superkids' Wraparound Club will be continuing after Easter. The club is suitable for children from Reception to Year 4 and is open from 3:15pm-6:00pm. The cost of the sessions are as follows: 3:15pm-4:30pm: £5.00 and 4:30pm-6:00: £5.00. The capacity of the club is 20 children per day. The price includes a small tea for the children which they are involved in making/preparing themselves.

We are also pleased to confirm that we will be continuing to offer 30-hour Nursery provision after Easter. #### NEW PROCEDURE FOR START AND END OF THE SCHOOL DAY

We would like to make some minor changes to the organisation of our school day. Nursery children should continue to come into school at 8:45am through the Nursery door. The Lighthouse children will continue with their usual arrangement, through their own classroom door. Everyone else (from Reception to Year 4) should make their way to the main yard (where the shelter is). The gates will be opened from 8:30am. At 8:55am, all teachers will come to the main yard and a whistle will be blown. This will indicate time to line up. At 8:58am, a teacher will ring the school bell. All children should be lined up with their teachers after the bell. Classes will then make their way into the school building with their teacher. School finish times are: Reception, Y1 and Y2 at 3:10pm and Y3 and Y4 at 3:15pm. Classes will leave from their usual doors. We request that parents and carers make themselves clearly visible, in each class area.
