Transition Day for Reception 2018 Children

There are two key events for children currently in NURSERY who are moving into RECEPTION in September. Firstly, parents are invited to attend a **new starters parent's meeting** on **Wednesday 6th July at 6pm**. The staff who will be teaching the class will be there to introduce themselves and provide you with key information for the children beginning their time in Reception in September 2018. Mrs Bennett will also be available to speak with parents and carers. In addition to school staff, there will also be a representative from North Tyneside Catering and samples of the school lunch menu will be available to try. Our uniform provider, 'Anne Thomas' will also come along with samples of the school uniform. The uniform can be ordered on the evening.

On **Wednesday 11th July**, the children for Reception are invited into school for a **transition afternoon** to meet their class and teachers. Families are asked to bring the children to the main entrance of the school where they will be collected by the staff and brought down to the



classroom. They should arrive for 1:15pm and can be collected at 3pm. The children are NOT expected to wear their uniform for this visit. It is a relaxed opportunity to familiarise themselves with their classroom area and key staff so they feel reassured and happy to begin in September. We very much look forward to meeting our new children for Reception in September and welcoming families into our school.
