#### Improved School Entrance

Devolved capital funding has allowed us to significantly improve our main entrance by creating a new multi-agency meeting room and biometric finger print entrance system. The end result is fantastic and the creation of the newly refurbished space, which will be called 'The Cove' will allow children within school to access a quiet, calm space for group work or interventions.

The child minders will assemble at the end of the day in the main entrance to collect pupils. For breakfast club, children will be greeted in the main entrance once the breakfast club door bell is sounded.
