- o people drive their cars too fast, making us worry about crossing the road
- too many people bring their cars to school
- my Dad, who is a fireman, can't get out of his drive to get to work (as we live near school)
- when cars overtake each other
- the way that some grown ups park on the pavements when people are around
- o cars parking on the corner- it is not safe for us to cross

We really hope that the whole community will support us with this important safety campaign.
