



Task 1- How would you catch a star?

Task 3- Salt Dough Star Decorations

Can you follow the instructions to create your own salt dough decorations?

Equipment

- Bowl
- Rolling pin
- Star cutter
- Microwavable flat plate
- Microwave
- Beads (optional)
- Paint
- Glitter (optional)

<u>Ingredients</u>

- 1 cup of Plain Flour
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of salt
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of water



- 1. In a bowl mix the ingredients together.
- 2. Knead on a lightly floured surface until smooth.
- 3. Roll out and use the star cutter to create your shape. (If you don't have a star cutter, don't worry)
- 4. Decorate your star with some assorted beads-just by pressing them into the dough (optional)
- 5. Make a small hole in the dough so you can thread a ribbon or a piece of string through for hanging.
- 6. Place onto a piece of kitchen paper and put into the microwave.
- 7. Microwave in 10 second bursts checking regularly. This should take about 90 seconds. (It is important that you do it in short bursts, otherwise it will burn.)
- 8. Once dry remove and allow to cool before decorating.
