- Use a quiet voice and chat only with the children on your table
- Sit smartly at the table at all times Tuck your chair in when you are leaving the table
- Walk to and from the dining room and in the dining room
- Hand up if you need help
- Packed lunch children may leave when they have finished eating
- School dinner children must wait to be given permission to leave (due to the queue for returning trays)
