Pupil Absence Procedure

We would like to remind families that if your child is not able to attend school, a phone call must be made to explain their absence. From a safeguarding perspective, we have a duty of care to know that pupils in the school are safe and should they not be in school, we must know the reason why. Should we not receive notification, a text message will be actioned requesting school to be contacted. Thank you for your support.

Staff Car Park

The staff car park will now be closed from 8:45-9:15am and 3:00pm-3:45pm. This is to prevent people who are not staff at the school accessing the car park that could risk the safety of the children. We kindly request that only staff use the car park during drop off and pick up periods.



Arrival and Collection of pupils

We are experiencing problems with children being dropped off for breakfast club on the road, with the expectation that they will make their own way into the school building. It is important that the children are dropped into school by parents/carers to ensure they are safely in the building.

Also, please remember that children should be collected on time at the end of the school day. We appreciate that there may occasionally be exceptional circumstances where we will of course hold on to children and keep them safe with us. However, there are some families who regularly arrive late at school, sometimes up to half an hour. We have very committed staff who are happy to help but there are many evenings where meetings are scheduled and school is being used as a child care facility.

Playing on School Site

With the lovely weather and light nights now being here, we warmly welcome families to enjoy using our school grounds, including the play equipment. Our only ask is that the equipment and facilities are respected with children supervised. The safety and well-being of the children is the responsibility of the families out of school hours.
