Statutory Testing 2023

The last few weeks have involved some statutory testing for pupils in Years 1, 2 and 4. We have been so impressed by our fantastic pupils who have demonstrated a positive mindset and tried so hard to do their very best. The tests are always carried out in relaxed, encouraging environment so the children don't feel under pressure. They are a good measure of progress across the year but we also use so many other forms of assessment. At Seaton Sluice First School we celebrate the achievements of every child in so many different ways. Each child is truly unique and we want them to love coming to school. Please do not worry if you child is not quite ready to access the tests- we will always work in a way that supports individual needs and encourages small steps in progress to celebrate together. The results of the testing will be shared with parents and carers as part of your child's end of year written report. Thank you for your support as always.

Extra school opening hours from September 2023

As from September 2023, it is the government's expectation that all state-funded mainstream schools should deliver a school week of at least 32.5 hours. The White Paper, 'Opportunity for All' sets out this expectations and legal requirements which include:

- ✓ To meet for at least 380 school sessions or 190 days during any school year to educate pupils
- \checkmark Operate two sessions on every school day divided by a break in the middle of the day
- \checkmark To publish their opening times on their school website
- \checkmark To submit the length of the school's week via the spring collection of the school census
- ✓ By September 2023, all state funded, mainstream schools will be expected to provide a compulsory school week of at least 32.5 hours.

Following Governor and Staff discussions, it has been agreed that our school day will now start at 8:45am (as from September 2023). We will be asking families to make their way to the school yard for 8:40am, ready for the pupils to enter the school at 8:45am. The end of the day will remain the same (which is more helpful for families who have siblings at other schools within the locality). A new whole class laptop trolley travel around the school for the delivery of ICT- it will be very exciting for us all and means that the laptops will be more accessible for supporting other curriculum areas.

Whilst Miss Procter enjoys her maternity leave, we have two new teachers joining us (initially until May 2024). We would like to introduce you to Miss Emma Boyes and Miss Fiona Johnson who both have a wealth of experience teaching SEND pupils. We welcome them to the team!
