Examples of work to include in pupil portfolio

The journey of progress should be a celebration of each child's achievements across the full curriculum. Pieces of work should reflect pride, perseverance and should be completed independently by the pupil. The pieces of work can be used to form a discussion around their learning, what they have enjoyed and what how they will use their learning in the future. Pieces of work should include:

- ✓ Independent pieces of writing (from different genres)
- ✓ Examples of mathematical thinking, reasoning and problem solving
- ✓ Scientific thinking
- ✓ Understanding of the world around us
- ✓ Work that reflects an understanding of culture and diversity
- ✓ Creative pieces such as paintings and sketches
- ✓ Technical designing
- ✓ Photographs to represent experiences
- ✓ Examples that include real-life learning
- ✓ Examples of leadership and team work
- ✓ Historical information
- ✓ Personal record of real-life skills (such as riding a bike, tying shoelaces, using a knife and fork, crossing a road safely)

There is no expectation as to what should be included in each portfolio. It should reflect the child and provide evidence of their interests, learning, talents and abilities. The child should be proud of their many achievements.
