Spelling Rules: ay and oy digraphs. These digraphs are used for those sounds at the ends of words and syllables.	Spelling Rules: The long vowel sound /a/ spelled with the split digraph a-e.	Spelling Rules: The long vowel sound /e/ spelled with the split digraph e-e.	Spelling Rules: The long vowel sound /i/ spelled with a split digraph i-e.	Spelling Rules: The long vowel sound /o/ spelled with the split digraph o_e.	Spelling Rules: The long vowel /oo/ and /yoo/ sounds spelled as u-e. These sounds are usually found in the middle or at the end of words.
