

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### Behind the scenes of ... YEAR 4 - Written by Mrs Collins and the class

As part of British Science Week, we have been exploring 'growth' into space. At the start of the week, we looked at Mars rovers-building and landing on one and the impact of minimising force on impact. We also built rockets that could transport people, considering what was needed to make an object move and what would happen if the opposing force was of the same strength. The Rotary Club visited school on Thursday to present Joe with his prize- he was awarded the district Young Artist of the Year' and his beautiful watercolour painting will now go through to the national final! Finally, a group of Year 4 children went along to a workshop to learn British Sign Language led by Paul Whittaker OBE, an inspiring man who talked to us about how the importance of sign language for deaf people.
