It's a video made by the **World Wildlife Fund** to highlight the impact of the changes on Earth over the decades on wildlife such as chimpanzees.

You can choose to complete any of these activities:

- Pause the video at 2mins 57 seconds and write a description of Earth from space. Remember to use everything we've learned recently about detailed, interesting sentences including the use of adjectives, verbs and punctuation.
- Describe the concrete jungle he arrives in at 3mins 45 seconds. Perhaps end with the line..... *and then a tear trickled down his face.*
- Write a description of Earth, imagining that you leave and then return 65 years from now. What will the world be like then? Describe it and draw it.
- Research the use of animals in space trials. What do you think of it? Write an argument for or against using animals in space trials.

## **Extra learning:**

Maybe you are a budding environmentalist or an animal conservationist? Do some research about the threats to wildlife in the world in 2021. You may choose to focus on chimpanzees or you may choose another species. Why are so many animals at risk of extinction? What is causing the numbers of certain species to reduce? Are there any changes that can be made to our lifestyles to reduce the chance of some animal species becoming extinct?
