School Lunches

Unfortunately, we are unable to make changes after this due to the ordering process, except in exceptional circumstances.

If your child wishes to move from school dinners to packed lunch, we ask that you give at least 1 week notice, in writing to the school office to allow us to make the change, otherwise school is still charged for the meals not taken.

Choice forms and the new menu will be sent out after Easter. Please go through the menu carefully with your child to ensure they are making choices you are both happy with. Having seen a preview of the new menu there are some wonderful choices that we hope the children will enjoy.
