FINAL...WELL-BEING WORDS OF WISDOM





Dr P Knightsmith advises us to be square! This four-by-four technique is a way to take charge of your breathing. A version of it is actually used by the military- they call it 'combat' breathing, but anyone can do it. Imagine a parade-ground sergeant shouting marching orders (if you find that motivational!) but remember that this is meant to be relaxing.

- 1. Breathe in, count 1, 2, 3, 4
 (Breathe in deeply for the count of four.
 Focus on your breath and the feeling of your lungs expanding)..
- 2. Hold, 2, 3, 4 (Hold your breath in your lungs for the count of four)
- 3. Out, 2, 3, 4 (Breathe out for the count of four)
- 4. Hold, 2, 3, 4 Hold your lungs empty for the count of four)
- 5. And again (Repeat this process until your breath is in check and you feel steady and calm).
